GAGE CENTER PROTOCOL - DRAGON BUILDING

Employee Guidelines	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Staff will follow illness policy including temperature checks & 24 hr wellness standard • Staff will wash/sanitize hands prior to/at the conclusion of and between classes • Staff will have limited direct physical contact with children (spotting is limited to necessity for all instructional classes) • Staff will be diligently trained on procedures and prepared to enforce any distancing protocols • Staff will adhere to PPE requirements if set by the Jackson County Health Department • Employee travel will be monitored and isolation following travel will adhere to Jackson County
Building Preparation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facility Team on site to disinfect and sanitize in prep for 'return to work' • Use of recommended products effective against Covid-19 throughout the building prior to open and throughout each day • All surface areas will be disinfected/sanitized multiple times daily once reopened • Hand sanitizer stations throughout building accessible and monitored for refill • Drinking fountains are covered / students encouraged to bring water bottles labeled w/ name • Cubbies have been removed to minimize contact. • Foam pits are temporarily covered with mats to prevent students from entering the loose foam
Prior to entering	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Double check that you do not have a fever or any other cold or flu like symptoms • Pack a bag with a water bottle labeled with your name • You may include your own hand sanitizer and/or a face mask if you choose • Please no food items in the bag
Entering the Building	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recommend students have an adult with them on the 1st day back to help with check-in procedures • After the first week, Drop Off/Pick Up if able; No more than 1 adult per family in building. No siblings or children not participating allowed at this time • Parents/Students will be required to sanitize/wash hands upon entering the facility • Students/Parents will be directed upstairs through a new entrance next to the front desk • Marked stations in the mezzanine with 6 ft distancing are provided for students to prepare for class
Prepare For & Enter Class	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will find an available space, put extra clothes & shoes in your marked bag • Once prepared for class, students will be directed to the slide for a safe entrance into the gym. • Bag & water bottle will stay with the student during class. • Students will be directed to their designated class area
Parents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Parents will find a properly marked & measured spot either in the front lobby or the observation loft • Due to the limited availability of viewing, we strongly suggest waiting in your car during class. • Please observe social distancing in the observation area; sit or stand only in the marked areas • GAGE will adhere to capacity guidelines set by Jackson County, student ratios & stations will be modified in class programming. • The observation areas will be cleaned between classes
Class	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be required to sanitize hands upon entering their class area • Classes will have preset stations to ensure only other students in their class are touching and using the same surface • We will do our best to teach students social distancing • Cleaning supplies and hand sanitizer are available at each class station to use throughout class • We will not be taking a group break during class for restroom or drinks. If needed, students can use the water bottle they brought and ask to use the restroom. • At the end of class, the coach will bring the students & their belongings to the west end of the front lobby to meet their adult in the designated dismissal area.
Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At the end of class, parents will go to the dismissal area of the lobby to meet your child. • Stand on one of the designated spots to wait for your child to be dismissed • Students will meet their adult, get their shoes on to leave from the far west front door. • Everyone will get hand sanitizer on the way out the door.
Cleaning between classes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Employees will begin disinfecting/sanitizing all areas of their class area immediately to be ready for the next class • Front lobby, observation areas, and restrooms will be disinfected/sanitized each hour

Building Preparation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Facility Team on site to disinfect and sanitize in prep for 'return to work' • Use of recommended products effective against Covid-19 throughout the building prior to open and throughout each day • All surface areas will be disinfected/sanitized multiple times daily once reopened
Prior to entering	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Double check that you do not have a fever or any other cold or flu like symptoms • Pack a bag with a water bottle labeled with your name • You may include your own hand sanitizer and/or a face mask if you choose • Please no food items in the bag
Entering the Building	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Recommend students have an adult with them on the 1st day back to help with check-in procedures • For Ninja, Martial Arts, and Dance classes, after the first week, Drop Off/Pick Up is suggested • No more than 1 adult/family in building. No siblings or children not participating allowed at this time • Parents/Students will be required to sanitize/wash hands upon entering the facility • All Students/Parents will enter the building through the front entrance and proceed through door to gym area.
Ninja Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Ninja students will turn left and the enter class processing area through the new gate • Students will find an available marked station with 6 foot distancing to prepare for class • Put any extra clothes/shoes in your marked bag and have a water bottle labeled with your name • Wait there until your coach starts class
Preschool Students/ Parent	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Preschool students and one adult will turn right as you enter the gym area • There are marked stations along the wall with 6 foot distancing for Dragonfly students to wait for class. These will also act as viewing stations for the attending adult. • Students will enter the classroom through the double doors & find color stations to place their belongings • At the end of class, students will collect their belongings & will exit through the mini door located in the front lobby to meet their adult
Parents	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Find a properly marked & measured spot either in the front lobby or the upstairs viewing area • Due to the limited availability of viewing, we strongly suggest waiting in your car during class. • Please observe social distancing in the observation area; sit or stand only in the marked areas • GAGE will adhere to capacity guidelines set by Jackson County, student ratios & stations will be modified in class programming.
Class	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students will be required to sanitize hands upon entering their class area • Classes will have preset stations to ensure only other students in their class are touching and using the same surface • We will do our best to teach students social distancing • Cleaning supplies and hand sanitizer are available at each class station to use throughout class • We will not be taking a group break during class for restroom or drinks. If needed, students can use
Dismissal	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • At the end of class, parents will go to the dismissal area of the lobby to meet your child. • Stand on one of the designated spots to wait for your child to be dismissed • Students will meet their adult, get their shoes on to leave from the far west front door.
